Mr. John Revier is the executive director of Idaho National Laboratory's External Engagement and Communications directorate. In this role, he helps make INL an innovation leader and strong partner to governments, academia, and industry across the region and beyond.

Revier helps enhance the effectiveness, efficiency, and integration of externally facing elements and activities at INL. This helps the laboratory speak with one voice to external audiences. The External Engagement and Communications directorate includes Industry Engagement and Technology Transitions, Community and Regional Engagement, K-12 Education Programs, Governmental Affairs (state and federal), and Communications organizations.

Revier has been with INL since 2015 and was previously director of State and Regional Government Affairs. In this capacity, he was the primary interface for the laboratory with the state of Idaho, local governments and other stakeholders within the region.
