Mr. Carlo Melbihess is the director of Facilities and Site Services at Idaho National Laboratory. He also served overseas as the operations director for Battelle Science & Technology Malaysia in Kuala Lumpur supporting renewable energy R&D innovation for PETRONAS. He holds a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from the University of Washington in Seattle, and is a certified facility manager and active member of the International Facility Manager Association. He also serves on the College of Eastern Idaho Foundation Board of Directors, and takes a personal interest in math, science, and technical educational programs.
