## UNDERSTANDING TIER 1 VS. TIER 2 CCE EFFORTS

	<b>Tier 1 CCE Effort</b>	<b>Tier 2 CCE Effort (ACCELERATE)</b>
<b>Who Participates?</b>	<b>Tier1 Organizations</b> – selected because they deliver specific functions deemed highly critical to national security	<b>Tier 2 Organizations</b> – any critical infrastructure organization
<b>Level of Effort:</b>	Intensive, guided engagement conducted with the full support of INL and DOE	Self-led evaluation using CCE methodology
<b>Engagement Funding:</b>	Directed and sponsored by the U.S. government with in-kind contribution by the organization	Supported solely with organization resources
<b>Resource Provided:</b>	Full support of the INL team, including targeting expertise and intelligence insights  CCE Tool Belt to support execution	ACCELERATE training manual and phase templates developed by INL for use by the organization

## UNDERSTANDING WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT VS. ACCELERATE TRAINING COURSES

	<b>Workforce Development Core Training</b>	<b>ACCELERATE Training</b>
<b>Target Participants:</b>	INL Execution and Operations & Analytic Teams who will conduct full CCE engagements with a <b>Tier 1</b> partner	<b>Tier 2</b> critical infrastructure organizations who want to conduct their own self-driven CCE evaluation
<b>Purpose:</b>	Train Execution and Operations & Analytic Teams on how to function as a team and fulfill specified roles; how to guide an engagement; and how to expertly apply the CCE methodology and Tool Belt	Teach basic CCE concepts and methodology and provide a templated process to conduct a self-evaluation
<b>Class Size:</b>	20 (3-4 Execution Teams or Operations & Analytic Teams)	15-20
<b>Training Duration:</b>	5-day training	16-hour training
<b>Training Medium:</b>	In-person	Virtual and in-person
<b>Participant Selection:</b>	Participants are pre-selected to assume a specified role on the CCE Execution Team	Participants do not assume or exercise a particular role
<b>Structure</b>	Combination of classroom training and 1- to 2-hour facilitated exercises using extensive facility case studies; includes a full-day exercise to simulate a complete CCE effort  Participants are trained to function as a team, and exercises are designed to allow each participant to demonstrate their specified roles and responsibilities	Combination of instructor-led training with 1-hour exercises using a fictional case study that applies concepts and builds familiarity with the methodology  Training builds familiarity with the manual and templates, which organizations can reference to lead a CCE evaluation within their own organization
<b>Additional Trainings:</b>	Specific role-based training for Targeters, Analysts, and Facilitators/Notetakers  On-the-Job training and evaluation  CCE Tool Belt training	None
